

RPDA back from Mission visit to Nigeria

The Research and Policy Development Advisor (RPDA), Dr. Alhas Maicibi has returned to office after an official visit to Nigeria.

Dr Maicibi held meetings with officials of the National Agency for the Prohibition of Traffic in Persons and other related matters (NAPTIP) on modalities for the Nigeria launch of UNAFRI's Reports on Human Trafficking in Nigeria, where it was agreed that invitations should specifically be sent to relevant ministries' representatives, international organizations and relevant NGOs with members of the press.

Besides, the extradition workshop to be held in Ghana was discussed and a committee was reconstituted to plan for the workshop

He said the Assessed contribution of Nigeria to UNAFRI was a huge success because Nigeria was able to make contribution for a span of three years into the coffers of the Institute.
